Biblical Truth to Emphasize

God is Almighty!

Read & Remember

This Sunday, we will begin teaching through our VBS lessons. This year's VBS focuses on the character of God. One of our goals is to learn about God's character so we may see the same attributes reflected in Christ when we study the New Testament. This week's attribute is God is Almighty! We will read Jonah Chapter 1 and learn that God is All-Powerful, All-Present, and All-Knowing! God is Almighty! Jonah is a familiar story to most toddlers. This is an excellent opportunity to read straight from scripture, Jonah Chapter 1.

Questions to Consider

- ❖ What did God ask Jonah to do? *Go and tell others about him*
- ❖ Did Jonah obey God? *No*
- ❖ What did Jonah do instead of going to Nineveh? *Got on a boat going away from Nineveh*
- ❖ What happened to Jonah when he was on the ship? *A storm came, and He was thrown overboard*
- ❖ Who sent the storm? *God did – God is Almighty!*
- ❖ Who sent the whale that swallowed Jonah? *God – He is All-Powerful, God is Almighty!*
- ❖ Did God know where Jonah was, even inside the belly of the whale? *Yes, He is All Knowing - God is Almighty!*
- ❖ Who rescued Jonah from inside the whale? *God – God is Almighty!*

Jesus in the Story!

Hebrews teaches us that Jesus is "the exact imprint of the nature of God." When we learn about God's character (who he is and what he is like) we are also learning about what Jesus is like! God is Almighty! And Jesus, the Son, is Almighty!
