JUNE MEMORY VERSE:

"Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known God."

Philippians 4:6.

VERSE DEFINITIONS:

Anxious- Worried or Upset

Supplication- Asking

Requests- Needs or desires

THIS WEEKS STORY:

Samuel in the Tabernacle

THIS WEEKS VERSE:

"I will teach you the way to go." Psalm 32:8

FAMILY WORSHIP QUESTIONS:

- Hannah Prayed for years for a baby before she had baby Samuel. Does God always answer our prayers with a yes? How else can god answer our prayers? (Yes, No, Wait)
- Have you ever had to wait for something? Was it easy or hard?
- When Samuel was a boy he went to live in the temple (the church) so that he could grow and learn all about God's teaching. Samuel learned to listen to God. God actually spoke to Samuel with his voice but he also spoke to Samuel through the teachings of God. How can you listen to God's voice today? (Through his word)
- When Samuel was older and bigger why did people listen to him? (They knew that he was Loved God and Listened to God's word)
- Samuel Served God his whole life, What are some ways you can serve God? (By obeying his word, praying for others, telling others about Jesus, giving of your money)
