## This Week's truth

God Works Amazing Miracles to Rescue His People.

## Read & Remember

Find a comfortable place together and read aloud “God Makes a Way” pages 92-99

- ❖ How did God lead His people in the desert? *With a pillar of fire*
- ❖ Who was chasing God's people? *Pharaoh*
- ❖ Why could the Israelites not run any further from Pharaoh? *“a sea was in front of them”*
- ❖ Could the Israelites do anything to move the sea in front of them and escape Pharaoh? *No*
- ❖ Who made the wind blow and the sea part so the people could cross the sea between the walls of water? *God did!*
- ❖ What is a miracle? *A miracle is something impossible for you and me to do, but God can!*
- ❖ How did the people feel after they crossed the sea? *They were very happy and started thanking God*

## Jesus in the Story

“When God's people saw how God had rescued them, they put their trust in God. But God was going to make an even greater rescue for his people! He was going to send His Son Jesus to rescue them from their sins! We can trust God to rescue us!”

## Pray Together

Pray aloud, thanking God for making the sea part so his people could be rescued. Pray that you and the children would trust the God who rescues his people. Ask the children to think about a time when they find it hard to trust Jesus and to pray that God would help them to trust Jesus, the Great Rescuer.

## Worship

We continue to learn “To God be the Glory”. I encourage you to learn this song as a family!

## Memory Verse

We are working to learn Exodus 6:7 — God said, ‘I will take you as my own people, and I will be your God.’
