



# God to the Rescue!

Moses and the Great Escape from Egypt, from Exodus 3–13

## This Week's truth

God rescues His people!

## Read & Remember

Find a comfortable place together and read aloud pages 84-91

- ❖ Who spoke to Moses from the burning bush? *God*
- ❖ What did God say Moses was to tell Pharaoh? *"Let my people go!"*
- ❖ What did Pharaoh when Moses asked him to let God's people go? *No! I won't!*
- ❖ What were God's ten warnings called? *Plagues*
- ❖ What happened on the tenth and final plague? *The oldest son in each Egyptian family would die*
- ❖ What did God tell his people to do so they would be safe during the tenth plague? *Take their best lamb, kill it, paint blood on doorway. When God saw the blood he Passover that house knowing a lamb died in the place of the oldest son*
- ❖ Who died in the Egyptian homes? *The oldest son*
- ❖ Who died in the homes of God's people? *A lamb*
- ❖ What did God's people call this great rescue? *The Passover*

## Jesus in the Story

But this is not the greatest rescue in the Bible. An even greater rescue was coming. What was that rescue? That's right, when Jesus died on the cross, that was the greatest rescue. Just as the oldest son could point to the lamb and say, 'That lamb died instead of me' a Christian can point to Jesus and say, 'Jesus died instead of me.' That is why Jesus is called the Lamb of God."

Some examples: God is always in control. God rescues his people. Jesus is the Lamb of God

## Pray Together

Pray aloud, thanking God for the amazing rescue he planned for his people. Thank God for sending Jesus, the Lamb, to die instead of us, to rescue us. Ask the children to pray, thanking God for the rescue from Egypt and for the greatest rescue—Jesus dying on the cross.
