- ❖ What was the name of the scary Philistine giant? *Goliath*
- ❖ Did the Israelites want to fight Goliath? *No, they were too afraid*
- ❖ David was not afraid to fight Goliath. Who did David say would help him? *God would help him*
- ❖ Who did David say really saves you and always wins his battles? *God*
- ❖ What happened to Goliath? *David killed him with a stone from his slingshot*
- ❖ What is the name of the Hero God would send many years later? *Jesus*

## Jesus in the Story

**Say:** "But there was one more part to the story. Let me read it again: 'Many years later, God would send his people another young Hero to fight for them. And to save them. But this Hero would fight the greatest battle the world has ever known. This Hero is God's Son, Jesus.'"

**Say:** "Just like God sent David to save the people from Goliath, God sends Jesus to save us. David had true courage because he knew that God saves us. If you want true courage, the courage to do the right thing even when you are scared, then you need to know it is not strength that saves you, but Jesus that saves you."

## Pray Together

"God thank you that you sent Jesus Your Son to save us! Jesus is our True Hero. Help us to trust you when we are scared or afraid."
