Read & Remember

Find a comfortable place together and read aloud "A Little Servant Girl and the Proud General" pgs. 136-143.

- ❖ What was wrong with Naaman? *He was sick*
- ❖ Who wanted to help Naaman? *A young slave girl*
- ❖ Where did Elisha tell Naaman to wash to be healed? *The river*
- ❖ Naaman thought he was too important to wash in the river. That was too simple. He was an important person and should do something important so God would heal him! Did God need Naaman to do anything to heal him?
No
- ❖ What else was sick besides Naaman's body? *His heart because of sin*
- ❖ Who healed Naaman's body from leprosy and his heart from sin? *God*
- ❖ Who was God going to send years later to heal our sins? *Another Servant, Jesus*

Jesus in the Story

Say: "Remember the end of the story: Years later God was going to send another Servant to forgive as the little servant girl did. That Servant is Jesus!"

Say: "Only Jesus can forgive us; only he can save us, and it is all a free gift. There is nothing we can do to earn it."

Pray Together

"God only you can save us! Thank you for sending Jesus to forgive us our sins. Please help us to trust Jesus."
