Read & Remember

Find a comfortable place together and read aloud “King of All Kings” pgs. 192-198.

- ❖ Where were the wisemen from? *Far away in the east*
- ❖ How did the wisemen know that a baby king had been born? *God put a star in the sky*
- ❖ What city was Jesus in? *Bethlehem*
- ❖ Why did the wisemen visit Jesus? *To worship Jesus*

Jesus was a different kind of king. He did not come to be a boss. What did he come to be? *A Servant*

Jesus in the Story

God promised to send a coming King, His son Jesus. Jesus would not be like other earthly kings that we know. He is King of all kings. He came to be a servant.
