Jesus in the Story

Say: "What the disciples do not yet understand is that Jesus is perfect and powerful in every way. He has power over sickness, over death, over nature, and he can feed more than 5,000 people with a few loaves and fish."

Say: "Jesus is God and he can do things other people cannot do. He can take nothing and make it everything. That is who he is."

Pray Together

"Jesus, you provide exactly what we need each and every day! Jesus, you are All Powerful! Thank you for taking care of us!"

Sing

We encourage you to make singing a part of your family worship! We recommend following a structure of read (the bible story or scripture), pray (modeling the ACTS = Adoration, Confession, Thanksgiving, Supplication) and sing. We are continuing to learn "Great is Thy Faithfulness" (English) and "Incomparable" (Spanish) in class.
