## This Week's truth

## Read & Remember

Please find a comfortable place and read "The Captain of the Storm!" from the Jesus Storybook Bible pages 236-242.

- ❖ What was Jesus doing while they were in the boat? *Sleeping*
- ❖ What happened while they were in the boat? *A large storm came*
- ❖ Why were the disciples so afraid? *They thought the boat was going to sink*
- ❖ When they woke up Jesus what did Jesus do? *Told the storm to "hush" and it immediately stopped*
- ❖ The disciples ask a very good question, "Who is this? Even the wind and waves obey him!" What is the answer to their question? *Jesus is the Son of God.*
- ❖ Why was Jesus able to calm the storm? *He is God's son and is All powerful!*

## Jesus in the Story

Say: "Jesus is perfect and powerful in every way. Jesus can do things that we can't do. He has power over sickness and death, and he has power over storms, over nature. We can trust Jesus and have faith in him completely. There is nothing to be afraid of, because Jesus is always with everyone who trusts and believes in him."

## Pray Together

"Jesus, you are All Powerful! Nothing is impossible for you! Thank you that you care for me. Help me to trust you when I am afraid!"
