Jesus is the Servant King!

Read & Remember

Please find a comfortable place and read "The Triumphal Entry" from Mark 11:1-11 in your Bible.

- What did Jesus ask his disciples to do? Find the donkey that was tied beside the road
- Who rode on the donkey? Jesus
- What did the people put on the road before Jesus and the donkey? Their garments and leafy branches from the fields (This is how people would welcome kings!)
- What were the people saying about Jesus? Hosanna! Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord!

Jesus in the Story

Say: "Jesus entered Jerusalem and the people praised Him! Jesus came to Jerusalem to obey the Father, to be crucified for our sins. Jesus is the Savior King! Jesus deserves all our praise!

Pray Together

"Jesus you are our Rescuer. You died for our sins to take away punishment for our sins! Thank you, God, for your rescue plan and for your Son Jesus who died for us. Help us to trust you!"
