## Biblical Truth to Emphasize

God rescued Noah.

Please find a comfortable place and read “A New Beginning” from the Jesus Storybook Bible pages 38-47

- ❖ Why was God going to send a storm? *Everyone was sinning/disobeying God*
- ❖ Who was God's friend? *Noah*
- ❖ What did God ask Noah to build? *An ark*
- ❖ Who was going to rescue Noah from the flood? *God*
- ❖ What was the first thing Noah did when he left the ark? *Thanked God for rescuing them*
- ❖ What promise did God make? *Never to flood the earth again*
- ❖ What sign did God make that he promised not to flood the earth again? *The rainbow*
- ❖ What was God's plan to rescue the world? *One day he would send his Son, the Rescuer, to rescue us from sin*

## Jesus in the Story

“God was sad to see all the sin in the world. He sent a flood that destroyed everything but rescued Noah, his family and the animals. God would one day rescue the entire world by sending his Son, named Jesus, the Rescuer.”

What did you learn about Jesus today in the story? God rescued Noah. Jesus is our Rescuer. God keeps his promises.

## Pray Together

“God you are Mighty! Thank you for sending your Son, Jesus, to rescue us, just like you rescued Noah in the flood. Help us to trust you!”
