Jesus is our Coming King

Read & Remember

During the month of June, we are teaching through our VBS lessons on Sunday mornings. This year's VBS focuses on the hypostatic union of Christ – Jesus is Fully God and Fully Man. Our lessons will focus on the birth of Christ through his ascension and promised return. This week's lesson teaches us Jesus is our Coming King and until he returns, we are to live for his glory and serve him alone. In class, we will read a paraphrase of Matthew 25:14-30. You may choose to read this lesson from scripture at home.

Questions to Consider

- ❖ What did the master give to each servant? Something precious, talents (1 talent = 20 years wages)
- ❖ How much did the Master give the first servant? 5 talents Second servant? 2 talents Third servant? 1 talent
- What did the first servant do with his master's talents? Gained five more Second servant? Gained two more Third servant? Buried it and gained nothing
- Why was the master displeased with the third man? Because he did nothing
- Who is like the master and will return again? Jesus
- What should we do while we wait for Jesus' return? Live for his glory and serve him alone!
