- ❖ Why did the people want to build a tall tower? *To reach up to heaven*
- ❖ Why was God not pleased with them? *They were trying to live without God*
- ❖ What did God do to stop them from building the tower? *God gave them each a different language to speak*
- ❖ Can people get to God by themselves? *No, God must rescue them*

Jesus in the Story

“The people tried to build a tower to reach heaven and try to be like God. We can’t reach God and we can’t be like God on our own. Because of our sin, we need a Rescuer! God will send the Rescuer, His son, Jesus.”
What did you learn about Jesus today in the story? Jesus is our Rescuer. God keeps his promises.”
