

Frequently Asked Questions About Kid's Day Out

What do I send with my child to KDO?

Please make sure to label belongings with your child's first name and last initial.

- A ready to eat lunch
- Refillable water bottle
- Diapers/Pull-Ups (if applicable)
- Change of clothing to match the current season
- Light Jacket
- Pacifier and/or lovey

Is Snack Provided?

Yes, each class is given a daily snack. Our options include goldfish, animal crackers, ritz crackers, veggie straws, and cheese-its. If you prefer to send your child their own snack due to allergy or preference you are welcome to. Please have bag or container labeled with first name and last initial.

Who Can Pick-Up my child from KDO?

KDO only releases children to those who are on the pick-up list that is on file. If a change should arise, please reach out via text or email to the Director or Assistant Director with the name of the new person along with a copy of their driver's license. The Director or Assistant Director will verify the name and picture before releasing the child/ren. If KDO is not informed of a pick-up change, we will not release your child/ren until contact with the parent or legal guardian is confirmed.

Is Tuition Discounted for Missed Days?

Tuition is based upon a set number of days for each school year giving families a consistent price. There are no discounts offered for missed days such as sickness or vacations.

Can I Drop-Off My Child Late?

Yes, you are welcome to drop-off your child later than our start time of 9:00 AM.

What Does a Typical Day Look Like?

Below is a basic overview of our day:

9 AM – Doors open for drop-off, Children Play in Classrooms

9:20/9:30 AM - Snack

9:45 AM – Morning Rally/Chapel

10:15 AM – Outside/ Gym Rotation Begins (each class plays 20-30 minutes)

10:30 AM – Craft/Sensory and Learning Center Play

11:00 AM - 12:00 PM – Lunch begins during this hour depending on age of children

12:00 PM - 2:00 PM - Younger children nap

1:30 PM – Pre-K goes to play outside or gym around 1:30

2:15 PM – Doors open for pick-up

2:30 PM* – All children must be picked up
